GP suggested that as a committee we should actively identify potential talent in the county over the next twelve months by visiting schools who have a clay shooting syllabus then spread the net wider to include educational establishments who have shown an interest in their pupils taking up the sport. Our emphasis will be upon identifying young shots with an aim to bring them to the national squad's attention for

2016 or 2020. MB suggested that we should take 2 Juniors / Colts / Fillies from the trap disciplines and 2 Juniors / Colts / Fillies from Sporting to give a good cross section. PB suggested that the committee adopt and publish a selection process document. PB to draft for AGM.

4. Chris Windebank has offered to provide banners for the event, PB to discuss sizes and potential costs, then report to committee for approval.
5. PB announced the cost of an advertisement in Pull! Magazine for the event at £150 for a ¼ page. The committee approved the cost.
