Previous Minutes – As some of our committee are new and could not therefore ratify the contents of the previous minutes, these were accepted by rote.

Agenda:

1. County Championship Dates

MB recapped the dates currently agreed for the county championships with the remainder of the committee – PB agreed to publish a schedule within a week.

2. County Badges – Team and Champion.

PB spoke about the cost of the county team and county champions badges and were the committee in agreement to proceed with the re-order of badges for 2010 from the same supplier as last year. The answer was affirmative and PB will place the order in the next ten days.

3. Trophies

MB suggested that as it is difficult to maintain control of the numerous trophies currently owned by the county, but residing with competition winners – many unaccounted for- it would be prudent to recall all trophies and procure a series of smaller, less expensive trophies to be presented at the AGM this year, thus killing two birds with one stone. The county will keep the trophies on display in a central location, updating the plaques accordingly. The committee agreed unanimously. MB and PB to obtain quotes for the

replacement trophies for the next meeting. PB to issue a recall to members to return the all current trophies by June 2010, in Pull magazine.

4. Fundraising

PB announced the funds gained at the fundraiser in November 2009. GP stated that in the light of current economic situation, we as a committee should continue with our fundraising activities until next year and after finalising the young@herts programme, decide upon the most appropriate area in which to spend our limited funds. The committee agreed unanimously. PB to speak to Claudio at A1 to identify the best date for the event – a 60 bird re-entry competition - and an appropriate entry fee.

5. ZZ Helice

MB suggested that we should enter a County Team in the SER Intercounty competition for ZZ -Helice this year, PB to identify with Claudio and Teresa at A1 SG the best date for the County Championship. MB also suggested that we should try to recruit more Sporting shots into the team.

6. Recruitment

CH spoke about the recruitment of Colts, Fillies and Juniors in her previous county – Leicestershire. CH stated that as they had no youngsters shooting in the county at the time they prepared a few Coaching days where anyone who had shot previously could come and try shooting sporting targets with a view to recruiting them into the sport. PL suggested that we should widen the net and include adults in the invitation.

The committee agreed to advertise the coaching days, once MB identified possible dates and costs, which the county will offset after discussion at committee.
