### **Minutes from previous meeting:**

The minutes from the meeting of 10<sup>th</sup> May were circulated and understood by all present. The minutes were accepted as a true record and entered into the committee records. Proposed by AH, seconded by AN.

### **Chairman's Report:**

GP raised the question – Is there a future for the county committee when so few shooters support the CPSA at local level, in shooting county competitions attending AGM's or stepping up to the plate to become involved with projects intended to build the sport?

AN replied that the county level committee is essential to set boundaries and steps for progression through to Team GB for any that are competitively driven.

GP suggested that in the current economic climate financial considerations are playing a large part in holding back shooters of all levels and will continue to do so for the foreseeable future

GP proposed that PB write an article on the "Demise of Clay Shooting" in Hertfordshire, highlighting the impact of members not getting involved at county level and request publishing same in PULL!.

AH seconded the proposal.

### **Secretary / Treasurer Report:**

PB accepted the proposal to write an article as outlined by GP, AH and AN.

PB also informed the committee that he had been contacted by Colin Butler at head office to obtain the contact details of Cheryl Hall. Apparently Cheryl has national and county Sporting trophies which she has failed to return. PB informed Colin that she also was in possession of the Hertfordshire Sporting trophy, again it had not been returned in due time for presentation to the current winner of

the county championship. Colin made it clear that the implications were, unless Cheryl returned the trophies she would face bans at all national championships being run by the CPSA and he would lobby FITASC to undertake the same for international championships.

GP requested that a standard letter be produced to go to the membership requesting the return of county trophies within the next calendar month to the committee, or a payment of £350 per trophy for their replacement.

PB stated that funds were still at a reasonable level for the county, due in no small part to the levies being brought in by the ESP teams and competitions.
